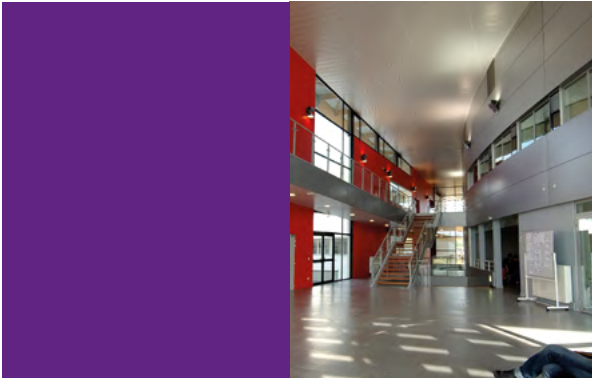

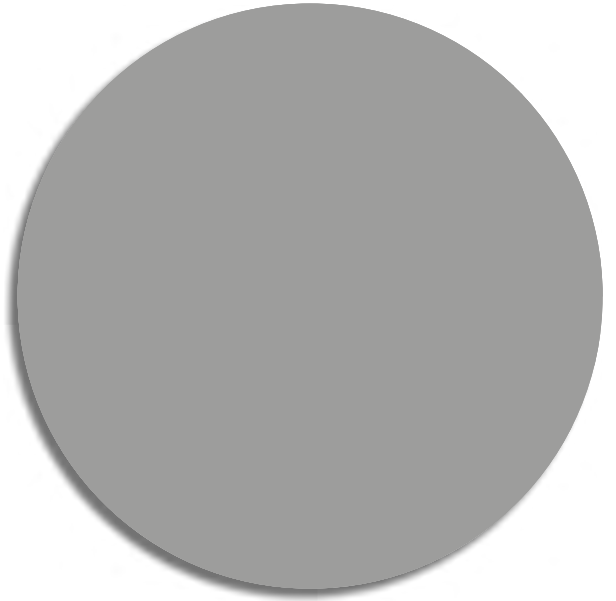

Here is the list of documents you MUST AND NEVER FORGET to bring along with you!

An original of your birth certificate in French provided by the French consulate or embassy in your home country (with the apostil) or a European birth certificate (multi languages birth certificate) issued within the last 3 months







All international students will need to provide to the international office a copy of their passport and visa.

once arrived in France, send to the OFII by registered mail

In all cases, a tax must be paid by purchasing a tax stamp marked «OMI» or «ANAEM».

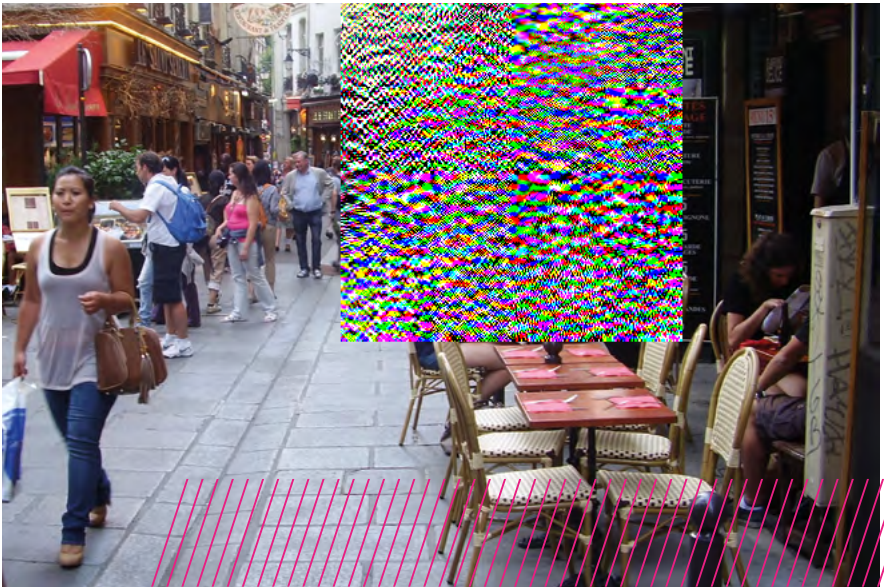
