Theme

Nurturing Globally Competitive Talents through Chinese-Japanese Joint Online Teaching

Overview

This project provides courses jointly offered by Chinese and Japanese universities with the purpose of co-cultivating globally competitive talents. The project, taking the form of international joint teaching, offers lectures, discussions, cultural instructions and other activities, the topics of which include: Course 1-- Universities' International Education in the Internet Age; Course 2-- Discovery and Speculation : New Trend of Chinese and Japanese Folklore; Course 3-- Progress of Geolinguistics and its Research; Course 4-- " Memory of Jiangsu's Cities " found in Japanese classics. This summer school course, featuring cultural comparison and Frontier Academics , offers in-depth joint online courses in order to help students sense the social and cultural differences between China and Japan, promote mutual understanding, train cross cultural communication skills, and enhance the exchange of Chinese and Japanese young students.
