The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill is the nation's oldest public university, founded in 1789. The institution is consistently ranked among the best in academic quality, research, diversity, engagement and international presence, and it ranks 47th in the world according to The Times World University Ranking, and 5th Public University according to US News. The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill is an excellent teaching and research institution and provides extensive library support for these central activities. The UNC campus has 16 libraries available to students. UNC's library system is the 20th largest in the United States and holds 3.85 million volumes and is also accessible online.

The University is in Chapel Hill, a sophisticated small town that's part of a larger and easily accessible Raleigh-Durham metropolitan area – an area that the U.S. Census recognizes as having the biggest gain of any metropolitan areas in the past ten years. With nearly 1.5 million people, the community offers a range of collegiate activities, professional activities, cultural events, and more.

Whether you can join us at UNC for 5 weeks in the summer or a whole academic year, there is a variety of courses offered under the College of Arts and Science that you could choose from.


